Welcome scored the TD. Daniels passed Sosnowski for the two points on that play.

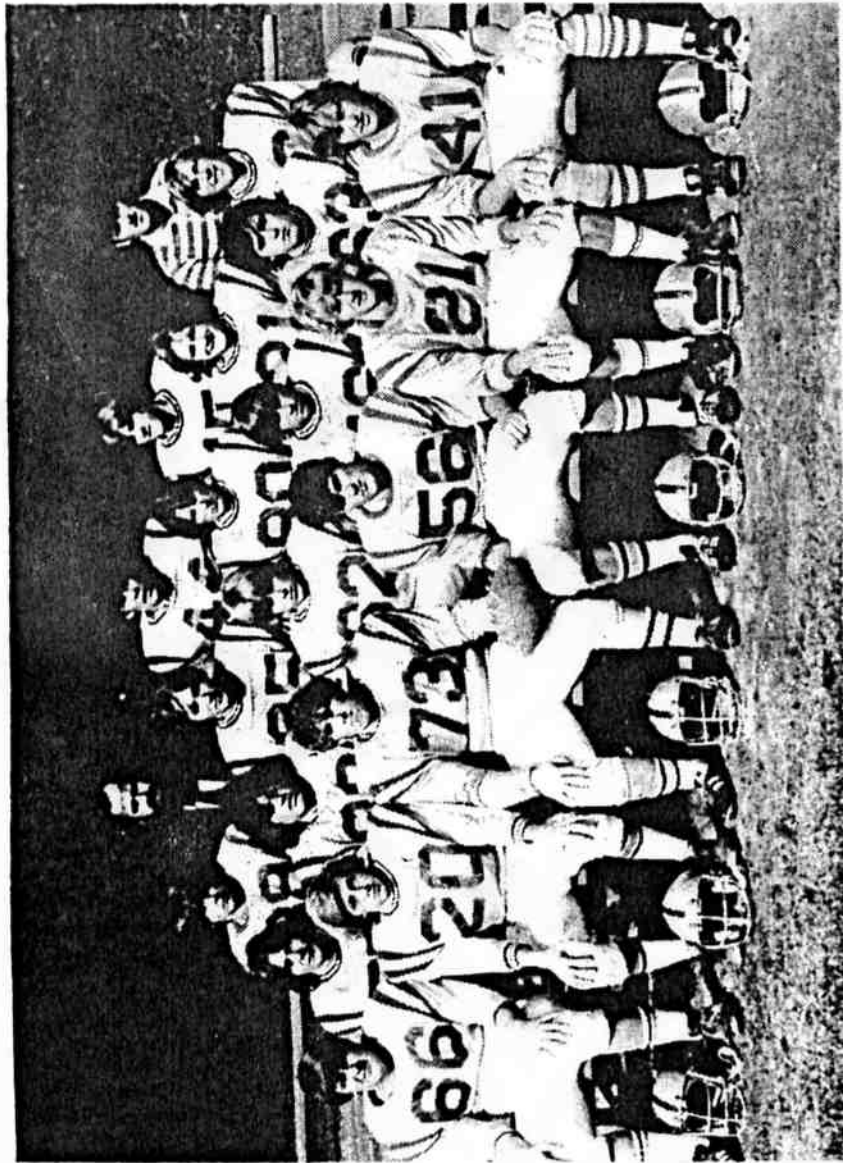
Royer Daniels, Sosnowski combined to score the final five touchdowns of the bout Gilbert.
